- 1st or 2nd dose available for all eligible residents who 12 years of age and over
- 3rd dose Pfizer Booster for eligible residents (please see behind for eligibility)
- 3rd dose **Moderna** only for eligible **70 + age residents**
- No appointment required – walk-ins welcome
- OHIP is not required. Other forms of ID accepted

WHO CAN GET THEIR BOOSTER DOSE IN THIS CLINIC?

PFIZER VACCINE:

If you are part of one of the following populations and received your second dose of Pfizer more than 168 days ago, you are eligible to receive a booster dose:

- Individuals aged 50 and over (born in 1971 or earlier)
- Healthcare workers
- Designated essential caregivers in congregate settings (including long-term care home and retirement home staff and designated caregivers): Please bring documentation to your booster dose appointment that indicates you are an essential caregiver in a congregate setting.
- Individuals who received a complete series of a viral vector vaccine (two doses of the astrazeneca vaccine or one dose of the Janssen vaccine)
- First Nation, Inuit and Métis adults and their non-Indigenous household members

The following group is also eligible if they received a second dose more than two months ago:

- Immunocompromised individuals: Please bring a doctor's note or proof of prescription to your booster dose appointment that indicates you are immunocompromised.

MODERNA VACCINE

If you received your second dose of Moderna more than 168 days ago, you are eligible to receive a booster dose if you are also 70 years and over (born in 1951 or earlier)
