Junior Machine Operator

#### **WHAT WE EXPECT FROM THE ROLE:**

- To report directly to the Shift Foreman or Designate on an ongoing basis and communicate all relevant matters pertaining to Safely rewind finished product into Accu-Trak Drums.
- Remove bulk packages from the winding machine, package and palletize into finished product
- Read and follow the instructions in the Shift notes that pertain to the product being run, prior to starting work.
- Setup and operate the Accu-Trak Drum Machine in a safe manner.
- Rewind finished product according to schedule and specification into bulk packages.
- String up the line, change dies and butt weld breaks together.
- Verify that the identification tag for incoming wire corresponds with the product being produced. Maintain identification of multiple products simultaneously.
- Control net weight, cast, pitch surface material and physical appearance according to specification.
- Measure and record the outside diameter of the product, as required.
- Properly secure the inside end of each product, as required.
- Identify each drum or reel with the appropriate identification and operator code.
- Maximize the productivity of the production lines.
- Change parts when needed and correct problems before they affect the quality of the product.

- Submit samples of finished product to the Quality Assurance Department for evaluation at the appropriate time and frequency.
- Follow Permission Notes and Special Order Instructions that may affect the product that you are running.
- Supply the line with packaging material, including but not limited to drums, reels, labels, and other packaging accessories, as required.
- Report mechanical or electrical problems to the Production Team Lead/Foreman/Shift Foreman or the Maintenance Department.

- High school degree or equivalent required.
- 1 to 3 years of Manufacturing Experience
- Computer Knowledge
- Read, write and do general math well enough to keep the records associated with this job.
- Able to understand and interpret the specifications and procedures related to this job.
- Self-motivated, safety and quality conscious; requiring minimal supervision.
- Be mechanically inclined
