The Lead CNC Staff oversees the daily operations of TNO's LINC Program, ensuring the well-being and safety of children while being sensitive to their cultural heritage and values. They provide services with care, compassion, and professionalism, adhering to TNO's client bill of rights and anti-oppression framework. Responsible for implementing best practices, the Lead CNC Staff supports children in achieving LINC Program goals, promotes community engagement, and monitors supplies/resources. The ideal candidate holds a Community College Diploma in Early Childhood Education, is registered with the College of ECE, and possesses 1-3 years of childcare experience with knowledge of health and safety. CPR/First Aid certification, familiarity with CMAS requirements, and proficiency in computer use are essential, along with experience in diverse communities and an anti-oppression, LGBTQ+ positive framework. Fluency in a second language is an asset, and the ability to maintain confidential records is a must.

You will report to the program manager and you will be taking care of children while their parents are in class. You will ensure the safety of children in the care, and you will maintain, clean, and disinfects children's toys, furniture and shelving areas.

Vaccination Requirement – You must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19, subject to any valid medical or religious exemption from vaccination as provided by the Ontario Human Rights Code.

Screening – As a condition of employment, the successful applicant must complete a Vulnerable Sector Screening.
