You will succeed in this role if you have a College Diploma or a Teaching and Training of English as a Second Language (TESL) Certificate and Portfolio-Based Language Assessment (PBLA) Lead Certificate. Reporting to the Manager, Language and Skills Development, you will provide overall coordination and leadership to the LINC program including the Care for Newcomer Children and English Conversation Group. You will help to support the teachers and learners in attaining the goals set out for the LINC program and promotes the program to the community. You will also engage in various initiatives in support of language education & the integration of newcomer families into the community.
