Community Health Ambassador (2 roles)**

Health Access Thorncliffe Park (HATP) is an innovative partnership between Flemingdon Health Centre (FHC) and The Neighbourhood Organization (TNO), and we are seeking **Community Health Ambassadors** to join our team in a **full-time Contract** role. TNO is a not-for-profit community based multicultural and multi-service agency, located in Toronto, Ontario, with a vision of neighbourhoods where everyone belongs and succeeds.

HATP is a great place to work, and we make a difference in the communities we serve.

The role involves being a proficient **Dari and/or Pashto** speaker, providing accurate translation services, creating culturally appropriate health education materials, assisting community members with appointments, offering guidance, planning, and organizing health education sessions, collaborating with healthcare professionals, conducting outreach activities, and conducting needs assessments to identify barriers to healthcare access and develop strategies for improvement.

You will succeed in this position if you have a Baccalaureate degree in a health or social science discipline, or equivalent education and experience. Fluency in Dari and/or Pashto, along with proficiency in written and verbal communication in both languages, is necessary. The job also requires healthcare terminology knowledge, strong interpersonal skills, teamwork ability, experience in community outreach, health education, or social services, flexibility to work evenings and weekends, and knowledge of catchment areas.

Vaccination Requirement – You must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19, subject to any valid medical or religious exemption from vaccination as provided by the Ontario Human Rights Code.

Screening – As a condition of employment, the successful applicant must complete a Vulnerable Sector Screening.
