TNO EarlyON Child and Family Centre (EarlyON CFC) provides free programs and resources for children 0 to 6 years of age and for their parents or caregivers.

Children, accompanied by their parents or caregivers, can participate in quality play and inquiry-based programs, while parents or caregivers can access a wide range of resources in a welcoming and supportive environment.

This includes making personal connections and receiving support for their children through their transition from the early years to the first years of primary school.



## WHAT DO WE OFFER



### CHILD DEVELOPMENT SUPPORT PROGRAMS

- Early learning and literacy programs
- Weekly Gross Motor Skills Program
- A variety of drop-in programs focusing on early development and parent or caregiver support, including Come and Play, Circle Time and Story Time
- Specialized registered programs focusing on individual child development including School Readiness, Growing Together, Arts and Music programs and special events.

### PARENT SUPPORT SERVICES

- Learning and teaching environment to develop the necessary skills for positive and growth-based interaction with children.
- Weekly parent support group, including for infants.
- Access to a library for free books and toys, along with the opportunity to borrow.
- Information, referrals and consultations.

### Special Needs Services Individual Case Management and Support

- One-on-one intervention services by special needs resource specialist.
- Parental behaviour technique support.
- Individualized assessment, observations, case management and referrals.
- Support with family service plan, funding applications, subsidy appeal letters and consultation letters to other professionals.
